Contact your monument company or other contractor for assistance as maintenance of monuments is not part of perpetual care which covers maintenance of cemetery grounds. St. Samuel's Cemetery has purchased a new lawn tractor. If anyone would like to help with the cost of this it would be greatly appreciated. You can use the pink cemetery envelopes or a plain one with your name/ env # and mark St. Samuel's Cemetery.
