<u>St Mary's Gravesite Adornment Policy</u>—St Mary's has a large gravesite area that needs to be maintained on a daily basis. In order to keep the graveyard looking presentable, the workers need the cooperation of all parishioners who have loved ones buried here. It has been established that personal plantings around gravestones impedes mowing and can even interfere with the stability of the grave stones. No personal plants are allowed. You are welcomes to place adornments on the top of the gravestones (cradle arrangements), but keep in mind that these need to be tended on a regular basis. It is recommended that any adornments be removed by November 1st, and fresh ones can be put up in the spring.
